


Google Chrome Tune-up for P260

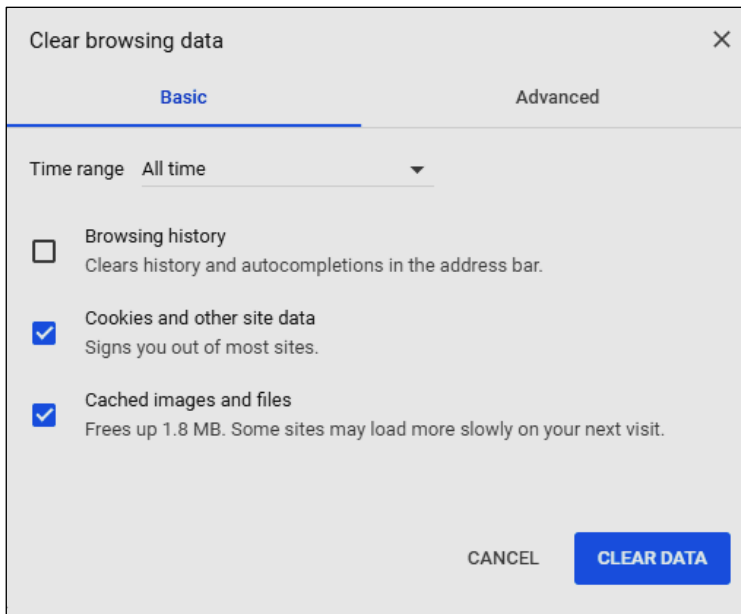
Here's how you tune up Google Chrome so that it better supports the P260 software.



Be sure that you are completely logged out of P260 or P260 Portal before doing this tune-up. Otherwise you will be temporarily locked out of P260.


Deleting temporary Internet files and cookies

1. Open Google Chrome.
2. Press **Ctrl + Shift + Delete**,
or click the Chrome options button  in the upper right corner, select **More Tools > Clear browsing data**. Chrome's Settings tab appears featuring the **Clear browsing data** dialog box (in Basic mode).



3. Confirm that the Time Range is "All Time."
4. Be sure check boxes two and three (see above) are checked—"Cookies and other site data" and "Cached images and files."
5. Click the **Clear browsing data** button, wait until the data is removed, then close the **Settings** tab.

Checking to see if you have the latest version of Chrome

1. Open Google Chrome.
2. Click the Chrome options button  in the upper right corner, and select **Help > About Google Chrome**. If you're not using the latest version of Chrome, an update automatically begins, after which you must relaunch Chrome.
